Mariner Kit for use with the HP LA1905wg 19-inch TFT monitor (Console mount)



The HP LA1905wg 19-inch widescreen TFT monitor is type-approved by all of the major international marine Classification Societies when it is installed in conjunction with our Mariner Kit MSI220.

The MSI220 Mariner Kit is designed to fit into a console cut-out and affords protection against the effects of vibration and shock experienced in the offshore marine environment. The combination has been type-tested against IACS Unified Requirement E10 and the relevant sections of IEC60945 (see below right for test details).

This type-approved combination of hardware and Mariner Kit can be used as the platform for your critical navigation, control, loading and general purpose applications (please check individual type-approval certificates for any restrictions).

Please note that although the monitor does retain its standard functionality we do not offer an automatic dimming function and it can not therefore be used in the front of the bridge where it may affect night vision. However, the TFT monitor can be used in any area where night vision is not an issue.

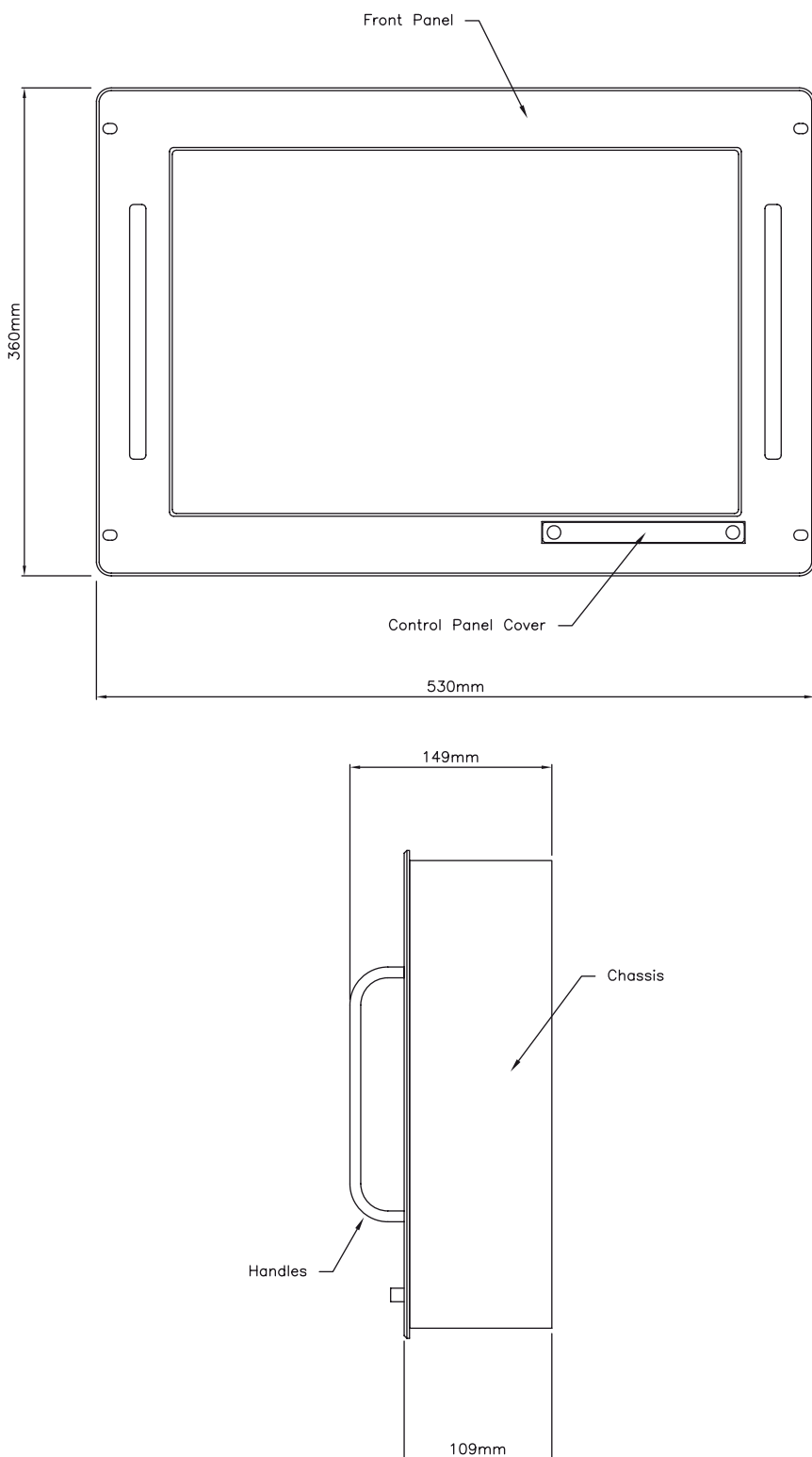

Type-tests included on the test programme are as follows:

- > Dry & Damp Heat, Low Temperature
- > Acoustic Noise, Compass Safe Distance
- > High Voltage, Power Supply Variation & Power Supply Failure
- > Conducted LF & RF, Electromagnetic Field
- > Radiated & Conducted Emissions, Electrostatic Discharge
- > Insulation Resistance, Burst / Fast Transients
- > Surge Immunity, Access to Dangerous Voltages

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OPERATING GUIDELINES

Although all our equipment is tested against extreme environmental conditions for the purposes of marine type-approval, installation should take into account the following guidelines:

- > Keep the monitor away from excessive moisture, direct moisture and the extremes of heat and cold to ensure, where possible, that the unit is within the following operating/non-operating ranges:

	Operating	Non-Operating
Temperature	+5° to +35°C (+41° to +95°F)	-20° to +60°C (-4° to +140°F)
Humidity	20% to 80% (non-condensing)	5% to 95% (38.7°C max wet-bulb)

- > Leave clearance on all vented sides of the monitor to permit the required airflow
- > Never restrict airflow into the monitor by blocking any vents or air intakes
- > If the monitor is to be operated within a separate enclosure, suitable ventilation should be provided

By following these guidelines you will maximise the life of your equipment and minimise service costs.
