The HP E24 G5 FHD Monitor is marine type approved when it is installed in conjunction with our Mariner Kit MS1740.

The MS1740 Mariner Kit is designed to fit into a console cut-out and affords protection against the effects of vibration and shock experienced in the offshore marine environment. The combination has been type tested against IACS Unified Requirement E10 and the relevant sections of IEC60945 (see below right for test details).

This marine type approved combination of hardware and Mariner Kit can be used as the platform for your critical navigation, control, loading and general purpose applications.

Please note that although the monitor retains its standard functionality it is not fully dimmable and it cannot therefore be used in the front of the bridge where it may affect night vision. The monitor can however be used in any area where night vision is not an issue.





#### **OPERATING GUIDELINES**

Although all of our solutions are tested against extreme environmental conditions for the purposes of marine type approval, installation should take into account the following guidelines:

Keep the monitor away from excessive moisture, direct sunlight and the extremes of heat and cold. Wherever possible, ensure that the unit is operated within the manufacturer's recommended operating range:

- Leave clearance on all vented sides of the monitor to permit sufficient airflow
- Never restrict airflow into the monitor by blocking any vents or air intakes
- If the monitor is to be operated within a separate enclosure, suitable ventilation should be provided

By following these guidelines, you will maximise the life of your monitor and minimise service costs.
